SCHEDULING POLICY DEVELOPMENT FLIGHT PAY LOSS

THIS LETTER OF AGREEMENT is made and entered into in accordance with the Railway Labor Act, as amended, by and between Hawaiian Airlines, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the “Company,” and the Flight Attendants in the Service of Hawaiian Airlines, Inc., as represented by the Association of Flight Attendants–CWA, AFL-CIO, hereinafter referred to as the “Association,” and jointly, hereinafter referred to as the “Parties.”

WHEREAS, the Company and the Association are committed to working together in collaborative partnership to foster a more complete understanding of scheduling provisions pertaining to Flight Attendants for both the Flight Attendant and Crew Scheduling groups; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the Association will develop the Scheduling Policy in accordance with, and provided for, in Section 11: Scheduling Policy, of the Flight Attendant Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the Association will craft the Scheduling Policy such that it serves as a clear and concise and complete guide of the rules, practices and procedures relative to scheduling Flight Attendants.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

The Company will pay for Flight Pay Loss incurred by one (1) member of the Association’s Scheduling Policy Committee for purposes of the initial development of the Scheduling Policy.
