LETTER OF AGREEMENT

RESERVE FLIGHT ATTENDANTS – SECTION 8.H. (Checking Out with Crew Scheduling At the End of Their Duty Period)

THIS LETTER OF AGREEMENT is made and entered into in accordance with the provisions of the Railway Labor Act, as amended, by and between HAWAIIAN AIRLINES, INC., hereinafter referred to as "the Company" and the FLIGHT ATTANDANTS in the service of HAWAIIAN AIRLINES, INC., as represented by the ASSOCIATION OF FLIGHT ATTENDANTS-CWA, hereinafter referred to as "the Association", and jointly hereinafter referred to as "the Parties".

WHEREAS, Section 8.H. of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, hereinafter referred to as "the CBA", states "Reserve Flight Attendants shall check out with Crew Scheduling at the end of their duty period."; and

WHEREAS, the current practice requires Reserve Flight Attendants to check out with Crew Scheduling from the Flight Attendant Lounge; and

WHEREAS, the Association filed grievance AFA 46-43-02-06-14 – Requiring Reserve Flight Attendants to Check out from the Flight Attendant Lounge; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the Association are both interested in amicably resolving all issues related to grievance AFA 46-43-02-06-14; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Company and the Association voluntarily enter into this LETTER OF AGREEMENT upon the following terms:

- 1. The Company will, after consultation with the Association, implement a trial period wherein Reserve Flight Attendants may check out with Crew Scheduling at the end of their duty period prior to leaving any Hawaiian Airlines areas of the terminal building.
 - a. Reserve Flight Attendants will first be required to check their messages before checking out.

- b. Reserve Flight Attendants may continue to check out with Crew Scheduling from the Flight Attendant Lounge.
- Reserve Flight Attendants scheduled to deadhead after a flight segment must continue to
 obtain permission to check-out and not deadhead prior to leaving Hawaiian Airlines areas of
 the terminal building at destinations other than HNL. (Ex: FA scheduled to work OAK-OGG,
 then DH to HNL, and wants to remain in OGG must obtain prior permission from Crew
 Scheduling to do so.)
- 3. At the conclusion of the trial period the Company will evaluate its effectiveness and efficiency, and will determine whether to continue or discontinue the Reserve Flight Attendant check-out procedure. If the Company decides to continue the new check-out procedure, the Company may at its discretion, terminate the check-out procedure for and revert back to the current practice of requiring Flight Attendants to check out from the Flight Attendant Lounge.
