Ratification Bonus Purpose

Address: No % increases to pay scale since January 2017

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- Not a fixed \$\$ amount for everyone
- Based on a lookback

Considerations:

- Not all Tas have ratification bonus
- ► HA's bonus is significant

Overview

- Paid out over 12 months
- Paid and taxed as regular wages
- 401(k) eligible: 5% company contribution
 - ▶ 5% company contribution
 - > 2% or 2.5% (over 20 YOS) company match
- Based on average W2 wages for
 - > 2017
 - > 2018
 - > 2019

<u>W2 wages:</u> All 401(k) eligible income -Not Scorecard bonus -Not profit sharing

Total Ratification Bonus Amount: \$19.5 million

- Represents approximately 19% of FA payroll for 2019
- > 3yr lookback to January 2017, applying TA wages
- Same formula as pilots used for calculating total amount

Important Points

- ▶ 12 Monthly payments starting May 7th
 - ▶ May 7th paycheck will have payments for April and May

▶ FAs who retire/ resign will receive a lump sum

FAs on vol furlough/COVID Leave: payments suspended until return

- Once FA returns, catch-up payment and resume monthly payments
- Will not offset unemployment benefits
- ► FAs on a leave of absence (non-COVID)
 - Will receive payments
 - > Must be aware of all deductions and would continue paying medical premium

Calculation Formula

- Total pay for years 2017 + 2018 + 2019
- Divide by 3 = Average pay for 3 years
- Average Pay x 19.9% = \$BONUS
- Minimum bonus = \$1,000
- ▶ FAs with 4 mos seniority or less get \$500

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Simple Demonstration Example

- 1. Calculate Average of 3 years:
- > 2017 \$30,000
- > 2018 \$35,000

TOTAL of 3 years = \$110,000

- > 2019 \$45,000
- 2. Divide 3-yr Total by 3 to get average:
- > \$110,000 ÷ 3 = \$36,667
- 3. Multiply the 3-yr average by 19.9%
- > \$36,667 x 19.9% = \$7,297 = BONUS

ACTUAL BONUS CALCULATIONS

Bonus Payout Average of 3 Years \$11,783 \$59,156 \$89,998 \$17,926 \$99,278 \$19,774 \$23,595 \$ 4,699 \$14,302 \$ 2,848 \$10,531 \$52,874
